Who are we?

Interior Health was established as one of five geographically-based health authorities in 2001 by the Government of British Columbia. We are responsible for ensuring publicly-funded health services are provided to the people of the southern interior.

Guided by our core values of compassion, quality, safety, and integrity, we continually strive to live out our overarching vision - health and well-being for all.

Where are we located?

Interior Health is located in the Southern Interior of British Columbia. IH serves a large geographic area covering almost 216,000 square kilometers and includes larger cities as well as a multitude of more rural and remote communities. The health authority is split into four areas which include Thompson Cariboo Shuswap, Okanagan, Kootenay Boundary, and East Kootenay.

Does Interior Health offer relocation allowance?

Permanent and temporary placements may be eligible for financial relocation assistance to help you and your family with the move. Details should be discussed with the hiring manager or clinical recruitment specialist prior to accepting the offer and any relocation provided will require a 24-month return of service. Casual hires are not eligible for this program.

What about a signing bonus?

Eligible nurses filling eligible positions will receive up to \$20,000 in rural and remote communities and up to \$15,000 in urban and metropolitan communities, should they choose to accept a permanent position in eligible difficult-to-fill or high needs vacancies. Eligible nurses will be required to sign a two-year return-of-service agreement. Learn more.

What is the Provincial Rural Retention Incentive?

This **incentive** provides up to \$2,000 per quarter, pro-rated to productive hours, to nurses working in eligible rural and remote communities to a maximum of \$8,000 per year. Details should be discussed with the hiring manager or recruiter prior to accepting the offer.

How can I find accommodation?

Kijiji, **Facebook Marketplace**, and **Rentfaster.ca** are good places to start your search for rental properties. However, **Castanet** is a local news site that covers the Okanagan and Kamloops. Castanet does have a **classified section** that lists real estate and rentals.

Are there any additional resources available?

Welcome BC by the Ministry of Jobs, Tourism and Skills Training has many valuable resources, such as a **Newcomer's Guide**, for people looking to relocate to British Columbia.

MOVING TO BRITISH COLUMBIA FOR NURSES







Do I need to register with the British Columbia College of Nurses and Midwives?

Yes, in order to work in British Columbia, you must have provisional or practicing registration with the British Columbia College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM) prior to beginning employment.

You can apply for a position before you have your license! You just need your license before you start work, so don't delay your application process.

How do British Columbia's wages compare to my home province?

For registered nurses, **JobBank.gc.ca** has a **chart** that compares provincial registered nurses prevailing wage ranges in Canada.

Did you know? British Columbia is proud to offer some of the highest average wages to nurses in the entire country!

Are there minimum nurse-to-patient ratios?

The government has outlined the province's commitment to implement minimum nurse-to-patient ratios (mNPRs) in hospitals across British Columbia, marking an important milestone on the path to become the first jurisdiction in the world to have a minimum staffing standard of one nurse for every four patients in medical/surgical units 24 hours per day, seven days per week.

What is the Canada Student Loan Forgiveness Program?

The Government of Canada offers Canada Student Loan forgiveness to eligible family doctors, residents in family medicine, nurse practitioners, and nurses who work in under-served rural or remote communities that lack the primary health care they need. This change will help more Canadians get the health care they deserve.

If you are a nurse or nurse practitioner and you qualify, you could receive *up to* \$20,000 in Canada Student Loan forgiveness over a maximum of five years at \$4,000 per year.

As a non-British Columbia student, can I complete my student placement here?
